Overview

The Vehicle Retrofit Program will provide a maximum grant of 80% of the first \$5,625 and 50% of next \$7,000 to individuals, registered non-profit organizations, municipalities or private companies towards the cost of supporting and/or installing eligible accessibility features for a new or existing vehicle.

Basic Eligibility

- Individual Residents of New Brunswick
- Registered Non-Profit Organizations
- Municipalities of New Brunswick
- Private companies providing transportation service to disabled persons within New Brunswick
- Must be primary personal use vehicle

Seniors who live in New Brunswick may be eligible for a forgivable loan for minor adaptations to their home to help with independent living.

Basic Eligibility

- Must be a resident of New Brunswick
- Have an income below the established housing income limits for your area
- Must own your home and be your primary residence
- Adaptations for seniors must facilitate and prolong independent living
